### FOR YOUR HEALTH ~ STR ~ KNOW THE SIGNS

This time last year, my sister and her husband were out wasting time going to garage sales. After several uneventful stops, my brother in law, Ed, stumbled and fell in the driveway at one of the stops. He jumped up, brushed himself off, and commented how clumsy he was. He complained of a bad headache and they headed for home. Less than eight hours later, he was dead. If only my sister would have known the signs to look for.

Strokes can be treated with great success if addressed quickly. If someone falls, complains of the worst headache ever, has trouble talking, can't see straight, be ready to call 911.

Here is a quick test to remember.

STR

S – Smile. Ask the person to smile. Does one side of the face droop?

T – Talk. Ask the person to

repeat a simple sentence. Are the words slurred, is the sentence repeated correctly.

R – Raise. Ask the person to raise their arms over the head. Does one arm drift downward?

If a person shows any of these symptoms, call 911 immediately. Reacting fast can save a life.
